"I Have Lost My Son, but I Will Not Give Up My Lord."



Assume that the strongly denied is a Christian, who works as a housekeeper in Pakistan, where false allegations against believers are common. She was accused of stealing from her employer's home, a charge she has strongly denied. Police arrested her son and tortured him before her eyes. After she was sent away, her son was killed, and his body was dumped in front of her home. The grieving mother said, "I have great faith in my Lord Jesus Christ. He is my Saviour, and He suffered death for my sins. I am asked to convert to Islam every day. I have lost my son, but I will not give up my Lord. Instead, I will serve Him, and one day I will meet again with my precious son." (Please pray: A CRI partner is negotiating for a satellite television channel reaching all of Pakistan. Another partner is presently discipling Muslim converts in the country.)
